## FATHER ARULDOSS MEMORIAL & CHARITABLE TRUST

### **Profile**

Father Aruldoss memorial & charitable trust was established on 26<sup>th</sup> may 2000 in memory of Father Aruldoss who had been working through out his lifetime for the welfare of the poor and downtrodden people and sacrificed his life for their cause.

To fulfill his dream, the trust has a wide range of activities in its chapter. These include providing healthcare awareness, conducting regular health camps in the rural and sub-urban areas, giving education aids to the poor and have nots irrespective of caste, creed, religion etc. During these health camps the rural patients are properly diagnosed by medical experts and they are given medicines at free of cost. The patients who require specific medical care are sent to respective specialists and they are properly followed by the trust.

In the health camps that are conducted basic investigations are carried out to rule out diseases like diabetes mellitus, hepatitis, jaundice, hypertension etc. Women in the reproductive age group and pregnant women are identified and given proper medicines.

Iron and folic acid tablets are provided to prevent anemic complicating pregnancies. Giving tablets so as to prevent worm infestations to the children attending the health camps.

Mass vaccination camps have been organized to make people free from vaccine preventable diseases like hepatitis-B. So far many hepatitis-B vaccination camps have been organized and vaccines were administered to people attending the camps free of cost and people are also taught about contagious diseases and their spread, cleanliness, sanitation and how to keep their environment clean.

A mega health camp had been organized in VallamPudur village in Tanjore District, Tamil Nadu. A team of doctors including specialists and super specialists attended the camp for providing free consultation to that rural poor people. Health awareness programme, iodine deficiency disorder programme, HIV/AIDS awareness programme etc are conducted regularly in rural areas through meetings, distribution of pamphlets, posters, street plays etc. A rural center has been functioning at T.sindalai cherry village in Theni District of Tamil Nadu.

The trust also involves in some other welfare activities like providing iron box and sewing machines to that poor people to make an earning for their live hood. Career guidance and

counseling programmes are conducted to the out going college and school students. Financial assistance is arranged from banks and govt. to the students to pursue their education. Books and notebooks are provided to poor students of some size in every year. Health awareness programmes are also conducted exclusively for school students.

### **FUTURE COURSE OF ACTION**

The trust has decided to the establish a medical dispensary in Thanjavur to provide the above health care activities in an improved and an organized manner so that the patients may be monitored in a better way and an enhanced medical care may be provided .By establishing a dispensary the medicines may be preserved and protected properly and an un interrupted free medical care may be given by making use of specialist of philanthropy in nature

The founder and author of the trust Mr.H. Arulsamy is a Retd.Tahsildhar who was well known for his honest and selfless service during his service period.
